

National Liberty Museum's TD Bank Young Heroes Award: Terms and Conditions

Eligibility requirements: The annual *TD Bank Young Heroes Award* is open to any school-aged U.S. student from 5 to 18 years of age at the time of nomination. To participate, NLM must receive a completed nomination form by the published deadline that is submitted by someone other than the person nominated. Employees of the NLM, the Award's participating sponsors and partners, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate or win.

Guidelines/Terms:

- No self-nominations are permitted. Nominators must be 13 years of age or older.
- Additional documentation – including letters of support, press clippings, awards and commendations, etc. – can be included, but must be submitted with the completed nomination form at the time of submission to ensure consideration of this additional material. Submitted materials will not be returned.
- A submission is complete when the nomination form and any supporting materials have been uploaded to the NLM website by the published deadline.
- Nomination and supporting materials must be written in English.
- Nomination materials must be prepared by the person whose name appears on the nomination form as the nominator.
- Excerpts from nomination materials may be published on the National Liberty Museum's websites and affiliated social networks as well as in other publications at the discretion of Award administrators.
- The selected winners will be invited to the TD Bank Young Heroes Award ceremony in Philadelphia along with a specified number of invited guests (number to be determined by NLM based on space availability).
- Winners are responsible for costs and expenses of participation and taxes on any prize award.
- Winners and their parents/guardians may be required to execute a publicity/photo/liability release.
- NLM and TD Bank are not responsible for any lost, late, misdirected, or incomplete entries or for any computer or communication error, or any other error or omission, that prevents a nomination from being received or reviewed in a timely manner.

Selection of winners:

All winners will be selected by a Judging Panel comprised of NLM leadership and TD Bank executives. The Judging Panel reserves the right not to award prizes should it deem that submissions do not meet the Awards criteria. All decisions of the Judging Panel shall be considered final.

Selection criteria for winners:

Young Heroes Awardees must fulfill one or more of the following criteria and serve as outstanding and inspiring role models:

- Demonstrate civic engagement, using rights and responsibilities to become involved in issues affecting their school and community.
- Promote respectful resolutions to conflict, seeking to hear all voices and consider all perspectives.
- Promote tolerance and diversity, helping to create safe and inclusive environments for everyone.
- Demonstrate leadership, organizing and connecting people in a way that helps communities reach their goals.
